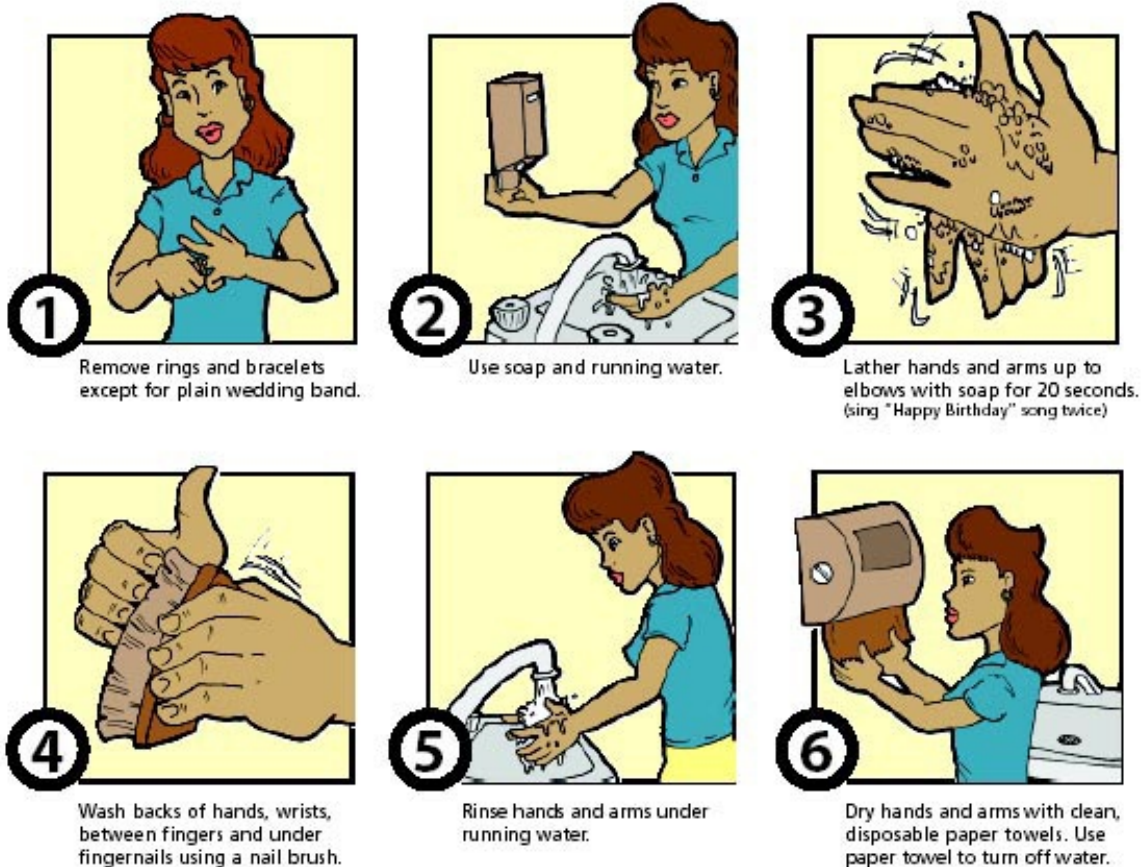


Proper Handwashing for Produce Handlers¹
