It might be FLEAS

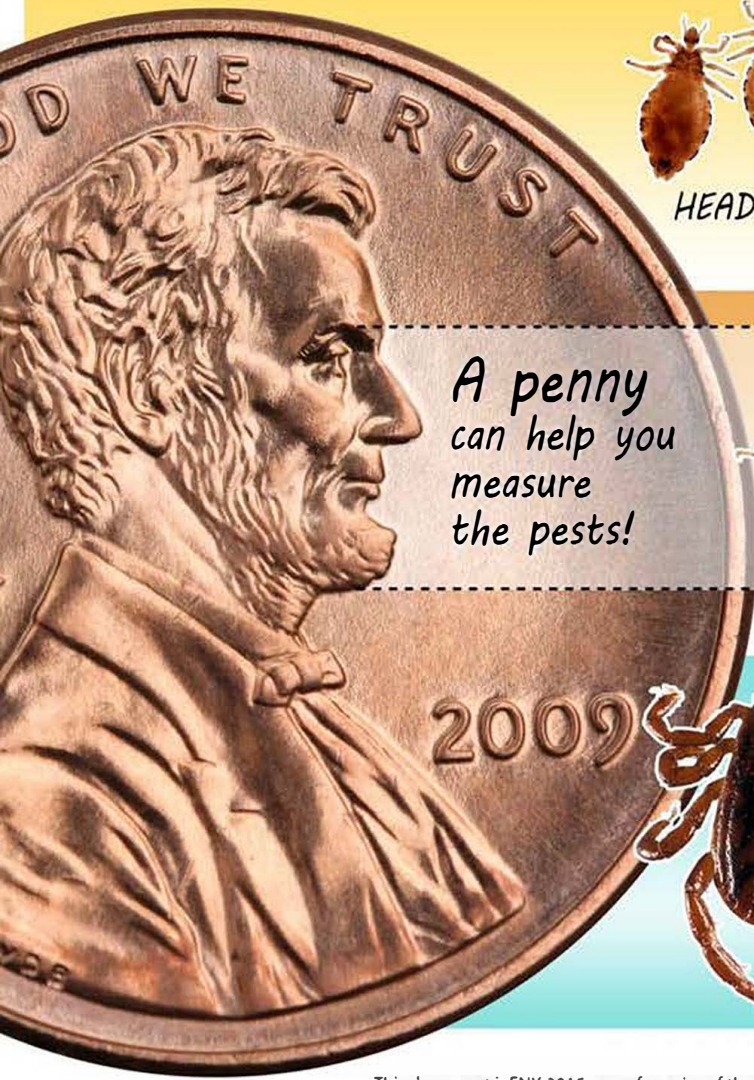
CAT FLEAS

HEAD LICE



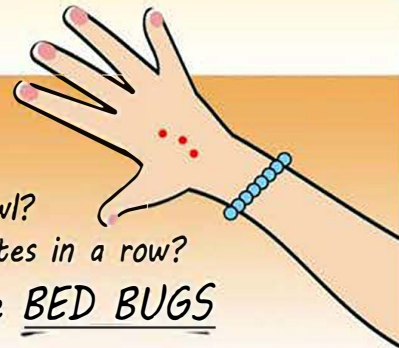
A penny
